MAD MUSEUM – THURSDAY 19 OCTOBER 2017

The DT Department is very pleased to offer Year 7 pupils a visit to the Mad Museum in Stratford-On-Avon on Thursday 19 October 2017. “MAD” stands for Mechanical Art and Design. It is based in the centre of Stratford upon Avon and displays interactive pieces of mechanical art, in particular; kinetic art and automata. Mechanical art is all about beautifully crafted, moving sculptures either made to have an exaggerated purpose or made simply for the fun of it like the machines and gismos used in Wallace and Gromit, Scrapheap Challenge and Chitty Chitty Bang Bang. The students will also have the opportunity to look around historical Stratford-on-Avon. The cost is £21.00 and includes the cost of transport by Riders coach. We will be leaving school at 8.00am and returning at approximately 6.30pm. Please ensure that your son/daughter has an appropriate contact number in case of an earlier/later return. Members of Haygrove staff will accompany the students.

Students entitled to FSM may also be eligible for further support, dependent upon individual circumstances and the specific learning needs identified by the school. Please contact Mrs J Witts before applying if you wish to enquire about funding.

All places on this visit are subject to good attendance and behaviour and the head of year has the right to withdraw a student from a visit if these criteria are not met.

7. Data Protection. Haygrove School Academy Trust, as the data controller, will fulfil its data protection obligations by treating all personal data, held manually and on computerised administrative systems, with due care and confidentiality. Personal data will only be disclosed in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998, and the purposes registered by Haygrove School Academy Trust. Data collected is used for registration and monitoring purposes, and emergency contact information.

Declaration

Having read the information sheet, I agree to my child taking part.
